

On the race days, the pits were abuzz with engines warming up, riders donning their leather racing suits,

clean and colourful bikes both vintage and old, prepped and ready to go. Bikes ranged from the 1920s, pre-1951 500cc OHV and 750cc side valve, hand change, rigid frames, right through to bikes of the 60's, 70's, 80's to 1990.

Some of the riders themselves, would have been from the 1940's however, despite their age and stiff gait, rode with as much enthusasm and confidence as the younger ones. There was a large contingent of riders, including a lady rider and one bloke who came all the way from the Northern Territory.


