

PHOTOS FROM YOUNG MOTORKHANAS

No doubt many of you will remember the Motorkhanas that were held each January at the Young showground. They were organised by the VW Car Clubs of NSW and Victoria. I don't remember how many I went to, but I was there in 1967 and 1968. And having recently received a camera (a Kodak Instamatic) for my birthday or Christmas (I forget which), I took a lot of photos! At the time, I wrote very detailed descriptions on the back of the photos when I got them developed. So here are some photos, along with my (edited) descriptions.

<u>1967 – THE YEAR IT WAS MUDDY</u>



Left: There were only 3 VWs there; and they are all in this photo. Closest is a 1600TS.



<u>Right:</u> A very muddy Morris Cooper. I noted that the front-wheel-drive cars seemed to go very well in the muddy conditions.



Left: This Mini Moke had a Morris Cooper engine and was driven by Bob Baker. Bob and his brother Frank ran the local newsagency, and during the week the Moke was used to deliver newspapers. I noted that it even beat a Morris Cooper in one race.



<u>Right:</u> This Zephyr ute was driven by Phil, "The Drifter" Barton.

<u> 1968 – THE YEAR IT WAS DUSTY</u>



Left: Austin Healey Sprite. It had a modified engine, and "went like crazy." I commented, "This took off and just rocketed down the course like a mad thing." It beat the Holden in the background.



<u>Right:</u> Holden HR. It was very spectacular and kicked up a lot of dust throughout the day – firstly from wheelspin when taking off, then in spectacular cornering. I said that in the corners it understeered until the driver got the back sliding around; all of which churned up more dust.





Left and Right: This Fiat 124 performed very well. I commented that it handled very well and seemed "very stable and controllable." I commented that, as a car, it was probably the most impressive on the day – to me anyway. (Not in results particularly, just as a car and the way it handled the course).





These three photos above I described as "Same corner, same enthusiasm".

The navigator hanging out the side had to throw a flag in the bin and then accelerate down to the next hairpin corner and do it again.

The EH Holden was a 179. The VW and the Austin Healey Sprite were both highly modified.

<u>1968 – THE YEAR IT WAS DUSTY (cont)</u>



Left: This EH Holden was driven by Phillip "The Drifter" Barton". I commented that it was a bit outclassed in power and handling by some of the competition, although looked very spectacular; and I said that it "got lucky a couple of times."



<u>Right:</u> I commented that the VWs all went well and were hotted-up. I said, "They sounded like refugees from Oran Park" (the racetrack). (Well, the event was run by VW Clubs, so they had to perform well!)




Left and Right: The Baker's Mini Moke again, this time (on the left) driven by Frank Baker. On the right I commented that it was being driven by, "A very competent 18-year old girl, competing in her first Motorkhana". This shows her driving, and the "navigator" steadying himself ready to pick up the flag.




